

Parent Training Early Intervention Program

Group Details

- For parents of toddlers aged 12-36 months showing social communication differences (which may be traits of autism).
- A parent-mediated program: parents learn strategies to help their child communicate and interact socially through play and connection.
- Learning occurs with the support of a coach and a parent manual.

Structure

- Led by Psychologists
- 6 week program:
 Combination of 6 weekly parent groups & 9 individual live coaching sessions for a total of 18 hours of specialized support
- Virtual program, families can join across Alberta
- Strategies are taught to parents to use with their toddler

About Social ABCs

Developed in Canada, Social ABCs is an evidence-based program. Research showed that this program can increase a child's functional communication, smiling, and looking at (or socially orienting to) their parent.
